JUNIOR HIGH DISTRICT BAND

Any students that are in 7th, 8th or 9th grade that are interested can sign up for this year's Junior High District Band! The one day fest will take place at Seneca Valley Intermediate High School in Harmony, PA. This is a paper application only fest, so all students have to do is tell Mr. Danch they are interested and their name will be placed on the application. Selection is done through a round-robin process, so not all students will make it in. Typically 3 students from the 7th and 8th grade and 3 students from the 9th grade band will make it in. Students that are selected will receive music to practice and then will travel to Seneca Valley on March 26th for the fest. The concert will be at 7pm and parents are responsible for attending the concert and transporting their students home.

ELEMENTARY PEP BAND

The elementary pep band just had their first game this past Monday, January 22nd. We have two games left, February 8th and February 15th, both Thursdays. This is the areas ONLY 5th and 6th grade pep band, so it is a unique and great opportunity! Sign up forms will be sent out prior to those dates for parents to sign their students up for the games. These Google forms give teachers and Mr. Danch the information they need to be sure that students are going where they are supposed to at the end of the day, as well as what kind of pizza they like and specific details about the games. It is always a great time and the students really get into it!

GREENVILLE STEEL

MERCER COUNTY COMMUNITY BAND

The Greenville Steel band has been asked to play before the Mercer County Community Band concert on July 19th, 2024! This is a great opportunity to play for a very large audience, so we are very excited.

PMEA STATE FESTIVAL APPLICATION 2025

The steel band is also working on new repertoire so that we can audition for the PMEA State Festival for 2025. If accepted, the steel band will get to travel to the Kalahari in the Poconos in April 2025 and perform for music educators and students from across the entire state of Pennsylvania.

STEEL BAND PARADE TRAILER

The Greenville Steel band is currently on the hunt for a trailer to use to perform in parades. Ideally this would be a flatbed trailer. We will weld posts on to the sides of the trailer to use as steel stands and secure the drums. This will allow us to start looking out further for opportunities for our steel band to perform!

MARCHING BAND 2024-2025

It is hard to believe that we are already talking about next year's marching band, but that's how it always goes! We try to stay ahead of everything so that everyone can properly plan their vacations and other summer schedules. Remember that band camp is the only mandatory part of the summer, and that is because we learn everything we are going to perform that fall in that singular week in the summer. Many schools have band camps that are multiple weeks, but Greenville gets it all done in just one.

PROSPECTIVE MARCHING BAND CAMP DATES

Based on the prospective starting dates of school for the next year, band camp could be **ONE** of two weeks. We have to be sure to avoid soccer and football camps so we get the field time we need to learn. Until the school calendar is released, we are asking to keep these two weeks open. Once the school calendar is released, it will be **only ONE** of these weeks that we will use for our mandatory band camp.
